JACQUES CHEVALIER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Award

Each year one Undergraduate scholarship is awarded.

Candidate Qualifications

Candidates must have completed high school and be enrolled in a College, CEGEP or University program in the year the award is made. Candidates may apply even if they hold other scholarships, awards or bursaries.

Candidates must ensure that their High School, College, CEGEP or University results arrive at CRCA by ***OCTOBER 15th, 2010***. The decision of the Selection Committee will be based upon the students' academic transcripts and a confidential report, as well as on letters of reference.

Value of the Award

This award is valued at \$1,000.00.

Duration of the Award

This award is tenable for a period of one year. Candidates may reapply for the award next year.

Obligations of winner

The winner must be enrolled in a College, CEGEP or University program in the year of application and maintain a full-course load for the year. After selection, the winner must submit to the CRCA confirmation of admission to the institution concerned.

Method of payment

Payment of the scholarship will be made to the student before ***December 31, 2011***.

Closing date

As stated earlier, applications for the Scholarship competition must be received at the CRCA office by ***OCTOBER 28th, 2011***.

ANSWERS TO SOME BASIC QUESTIONS

1. Who can apply for the scholarship?

The competition for the scholarship is open to any permanent employee of an ***Active member*** of the CRCA with two or more years of service. It is also open to any son, daughter or legal ward of a permanent employee.

2. How is the scholarship awarded?

The selection of the winner is made by a committee of respected industry representatives chosen by the Canadian Roofing Contractors= Association (CRCA) who will evaluate academic achievement, need, personality, accomplishments, and leadership qualities.

3. Can a candidate for a scholarship apply for studies at any College or University?

Yes, the award is tenable at any Canadian College or University.

4. How many scholarships are offered and at what value?

Currently, 1 (one) Scholarship valued at **\$1,000.00** Canadian is offered.

5. How can a student obtain the necessary application forms?

Application forms are available by calling the CRCA or by faxing a request. We can also e-mail the forms to you.
